4. **Encourage** your members to attend their precinct conventions following the Primary. This is the first step to becoming a delegate to the RPT State Convention.
5. **Make a list** with contact information for all Republican candidates in your area, and give them your contact info as well. They need to know that we are ready to help.
6. **Attend the 9th Biennial TFRW Club Leadership Workshop in San Antonio on February 2, 2008**. You will learn from TFRW leaders and other Campaign Chairmen from across Texas, and its fun! The 2008 - 2009 TFRW Handbook will be distributed at this time and your club also earns John Goodwin Tower award points for attendance.
