Each year three young women receive the opportunity to spend six weeks working at NFRW. Applicants must be U.S. Citizens in their junior year of college or college students age 21 and over, having completed high school but not yet graduated from college. The internship provides housing, round-trip airfare, and a small monetary allowance.

In her application, Kindal wrote, "All I could think about when I found this scholarship was the fact that I could possibly be in D.C. for six weeks during an election year! That would be absolutely epic for me. I have had the opportunity to volunteer for a state representative and I have found that direct democracy is something that I find endlessly engaging. I love being able to help out in any way that I can."
