A Resolution to Officially Endorse Senator John McCain, Candidate for President of the United States of America

The members of the Texas Federation of the Republican Women resolve that

WHEREAS, John McCain graduated from the United States Naval Academy and served twenty-two years as a United States Naval aviator; and

WHEREAS, he on his twenty-third bombing mission over Vietnam was shot down on October 26, 1967, and spent five and a half years as a prisoner of war in the Hanoi Hilton; and

WHEREAS, he served for two years in the United States House of Representatives and has served 22 years in the United States Senate; and

WHEREAS, the results of the Republican primaries held so far have given John McCain the delegates needed to win the Republican nomination for President;

WHEREAS, winning the presidency in the 2008 election is paramount to the future of the nation and the Republican Party; and

WHEREAS, unity in the Republican Party will be the most important factor for Republicans to win the election;

Resolved, this 2nd day of May, 2008, the Texas Federation of Republican Women officially, enthusiastically and with pleasure endorses John McCain for President of the United States.
