

Texas Students Selected to Apply for Betty Rendel and National Pathfinder Scholarships

Four outstanding women applied for the Betty Rendel and National Pathfinder Scholarships offered by NFRW. One applicant may be submitted from each state for each scholarship.

Though all the candidates had outstanding qualifications, the scholarship committee selected the following to represent Texas:

Jennifer Davis was selected to apply for the National Pathfinder Scholarship of \$2,500. Jennifer is from Richardson and is attending Belmont University in Nashville, Tennessee. She was a delegate in 2006 and 2008 at the State Republican Convention. Prior to that, she served at two earlier State Conventions as a Page and Sergeant of Arms. Jennifer was selected for Representative Sam Johnson's first Congressional Youth Advisory Council for the 3rd District. Jennifer has participated in numerous campaign walks, and in has provided extensive church and community service. She is involved in sports, music and theatre.

Kindal Wetuski was selected as the applicant for the Betty Rendel Scholarship of \$1,000. Kindal is attending the University of Texas at Austin, majoring in Government and Sociology. Kindal is also the recipient of the Dorothy Andrews Kabis Memorial Internship and is presently at the NFRW Headquarters in Alexandria, Virginia serving her six-week internship. Kindal was nominated by the Lake Conroe Area Republican Women. Kindal has been working in the Texas Capitol as an intern for Representative Brandon Creighton since January. She has been involved in various campaigns and community projects.
