**A Joint Resolution to recommend that the United States Congress and the Texas Legislature enact legislation to require photo ID in order to Vote.**

The members of the Texas Federation of Republican Women resolve that

**WHEREAS**, our country and state were founded on democratic principles and have engaged in struggles to ensure that every citizen can vote; and

**WHEREAS**, Texans and all Americans take election integrity seriously and do not want their vote disenfranchised by fraudulent elections; and

**WHEREAS**, secure and fair elections promote our elective democracy, while even the potential for voter fraud, undermines faith in the election process; and

**WHEREAS**, voter identification is favored by a large majority of both Texans and Americans; now, therefore be it


