

According to TFRW Bylaws, Article XI- Nominations and Elections, Section 1. Nominations, A. The Nominating Committee of seven members and two alternates shall be elected by the Board of Directors from its own membership at the first meeting of the convention year. The Nominating Committee will be elected on Saturday February 7, 2009 in the morning of the Board of Meeting. The elected members of the committee will be published in the next newsletter.

This is the time to consider submitting your name for an elected positions.

TEXAS FEDERATION OF REPUBLICAN WOMEN
Nominating Committee Guidelines
(As Adopted by the Board of Directors, June 2, 2007)

1. Those wishing to be nominated for an office shall send in a Texas Federation of Republican Women Nomination Form with resume stating what offices they are seeking, stating clearly what their objectives are if chosen for one of these offices, how they would accomplish their goals and how their plans would benefit TFRW. The Form to be used shall have the wording at the bottom, —Should I be nominated and elected, I agree to serve,|| followed by a Signature line and a Date line.
2. Endorsements for potential nominees shall number at least three and no more than five, an officer, a member (either TFRW or a Local Club) and one other person who has worked with the potential member.
3. The Nominating Committee may actively recruit potential nominees and may themselves submit names of potential officers and shall interview prospective candidates.
4. The Nominating Committee shall take into consideration past job performance, qualifications for a specific job, and the ability of the potential nominee to represent TFRW in a positive manner.
5. Wherever possible, widespread geographical considerations shall be given to officer nominations.
6. Members of the Nominating Committee who desire to be considered for an office shall excuse themselves while that office is being considered; an alternate will fill their position. The committee shall limit the number of its own members who may be nominated for an office to no more than two.
7. The Alternate Members of the Nominating Committee shall be present at all meetings, be supplied with all information and subjected to the same guidelines.
8. Members of the Nominating Committee shall not discuss any information pertaining to those considered for nomination outside of their specific committee meetings.
