“TRACKING CAMPAIGN ACTIVITY HOURS MADE EASY”

I am your newly elected Vice President of Campaign Activities. My basic plan for the clubs is to invite you to a new system of tracking your clubs' volunteer hours for campaign activities and “Caring for America” volunteer hours. As a bonus, this system will allow the Campaign Activities Chair to easily prepare the report due to TFRW prior to Legislative Day!

Club Presidents and Club Campaign Activities Chairpersons this is a GREAT day for you and your club when it comes to tracking members' volunteer hours for campaign activities. The first in-depth presentation on this system will be given at the TFRW January 30 Leadership Conference. You will see more information on this conference in this newsletter. At this conference, me and my side-kick Lynn Oakes, my expert on this computer program, will give a step-by-step presentation on how the on-line system works. I will even throw in a five page handout that will lead you through the procedure.

The rationale for implementing an “on-line” system for reporting campaign hours vs. the current forms, which are either mailed in or faxed, is:

1. It is user friendly and it limits errors. More accurate and timelier reporting.
2. Limits the amount of paper to be handled by the chairs and the VP. Overall cuts down on paperwork.
3. Ease of reporting is enhanced by using the concept of reporting by “Area,” which is a total of 5 or 7 areas. Each club will be assigned an area. Once the CA Chair knows the area her club has been assigned, the CA Chair scrolls down to the name of her club and inputs the total number of hours the club members have logged for the month/quarter. Click on “Submit” and it goes straight to the VP, namely ME! The CA Chair receives the response, “Accepted” and she is done!! This is much more efficient than mailing in or faxing forms.
4. Easier to verify delinquent reports. The VP only has to review 5 or 7 sheets to determine which clubs have not reported their hours.
