BALLOT SECURITY: Election Day Questions?

The March 2 Primary is fast approaching, and many of our TFRW members will be in the trenches on that day proudly working as precinct chairs, elections judges, ballot board members, poll watchers, etc.

I encourage you to participate in your county's ballot boards where absentee ballots are verified and provisional ballots are reviewed. Your help is needed to properly evaluate questionable ballots. This primary election will serve as a training session for the general election where ACORN and other organizations pose serious problems. Also, please contact me if you have witnessed voter fraud or are concerned about any ballot issues in your county.
