Dear TFRW Presidents,

I'm excited to announce that VictoryTexas has launched a new online phone-banking program called Volunteer Connect that utilizes technology to enable you and your volunteers to support Republican candidates all over Texas with ease. You can find our new online program on our website at [www.VictoryTexas.org/phones](http://www.VictoryTexas.org/phones).

Volunteer Connect is easy to use and allows you to make calls from the comfort of your home or office. With one click, this innovative new program will call the phone number of your choice, including cell phones, voice over internet phones or landlines and get you started making calls identifying independent voters and as we get closer to the election, turning out voters for Republican candidates.

Your time and effort will help VictoryTexas rebuild and improve VoterVault, the Republican Party's extensive database program, and start gathering information on voters that will not only help Republicans achieve victory this November but also for many Novembers to come.

Here is how it works. First, **volunteers will need to contact Diane Parlapiano or Stuart Moss at VictoryTexas (contact information is below) and get a unique username and password that identifies them for the system.** This ID is important because within the next week VictoryTexas will be releasing details on a volunteer incentive program that allows volunteers to earn Visa gift cards for their hard work. Your unique ID will allow VictoryTexas to track your progress and let you know how effective your calls have been.

**After you receive your username and password, all you have to do is log in on our website and click "start calling." The system will automatically dial the phone number of the voter you are contacting and provide you with a series of survey questions.** The website has easy drop-down menus that make it simple for you to record the voter's answers. After completing the call, instead of hanging up and dialing the next number, you simply stay on the line, click "next record" and the system dials a new number for you. If you reach a voter's voicemail, you can simply click "voicemail" and the system will leave a prerecorded message - no more leaving messages all day - and you can move on to the next voter. If you get a wrong number, fax machine or even a bad number, all you do is mark it on the screen and move on to the contact.
