Prior to JANUARY 2022

Email 2022 Notice of Election of Officers to tfrw@tfrw.org
This must be submitted every year regardless if Officers do not change. Form must be emailed complete, and all required fields must be updated. A copy must be emailed to your District Director. Notice of Election of Officers is due January 1, 2022. CF-3.

Throughout the Year (2022 and 2023)

- Hold a regular meeting (at least 5 per year required). CF-1.
- Hold a board meeting (at least 5 per year required). CF-1.
- Review current bylaws, adding any required TFRW changes passed in October of 2021. A copy of our club's bylaws with all changes must be submitted and received, and a notification of approval from the TFRW Vice President-Bylaws, was received by June 30, 2023. CF-7.
- Give information about National, State, Regional Republican Events. P-4.
- Invite Deputy President and District Director to attend meeting. CF-2B.
- Contribute to DP and DD travel expenses or membership dues. CF-17B.
- Give a Legislative Report. P-4.
- Present a political or issue-oriented program
(at least two such programs are required in both 2022 and 2023). P-1.
- Collect campaign volunteer hours to send to TFRW. CA-2.

JANUARY 2022

- Submit the first installment of dues plus service charge POSTMARKED to TFRW on or before January 31, 2022. CF-2.
- Distribute a job description from the TFRW Handbook to each of your Board Members. CF-6.
- Plan your New Year with the TFRW Club Achievement Award guidelines.
- Club President appoints a Campaign Activities/Political Activities Chair, and a Legislative Chair. CF-5.
- Add County Republican Headquarters; TFRW President, TFRW Office, Public Relations Chair, Deputy President, and District Director to newsletter distribution list. CF-4.

- Make a plan to retain and grow membership this year. Remember, you want to reach last year's membership **PLUS** more! MD-1B. MD-2B.
- Host **any** quarterly TFRW Board meeting by donating treats or at least \$25 for hospitality. CF-19B.

- REGISTER REPUBLICAN VOTERS CA-4.
- Plan a Membership Recruitment Event to increase new members. MD-1.
- Plan a Membership Orientation. MD-2.
- Plan a date to invite a member of the TFRW Board of Directors to attend a meeting. CF-2B.
- Appoint a member / committee to welcome visitors and new members. MD-3B.
- Have Primary Candidates on a program. CA-1B
- Encourage members to be precinct chairmen, election judges, etc. CA-3B and CA-9B.
- Plan a GOTV program. CA-3.
- Provide a program/workshop that discusses state election laws, Party rules and organization, and the Party convention process. P-2

- Provide Federation structure information to members. P-3.

- Encourage members to apply for Governor appointments. (Bonus points for being appointed to a board.) CA-5B and CA-6B.
- Establish and Contribute to a scholarship fund to benefit a Republican Woman from your area. CE-2B.

- Nominate members for the “Tribute to Women” lunch to be held in the fall. CF-3B.
- Buy and donate a book to the library for the Barbara Bush Literacy Project and/or the Mamie Eisenhower Literacy Project (both 2022 and 2023). CE-2.

- Encourage members to work in at least one Voter I.D./GOTV program sponsored by the Party or a Republican Candidate. (Could be a phone bank, door to door canvas, etc.) CA-3.

- ORGANIZE a Voter I.D./G.O.T.V. program (Get Out The Vote) CA-3
