The Duties of a District Director are:

- A. To promote the work of the Texas Federation of Republican Women in her respective district.
- B. To visit the local clubs in her district and maintain close communication with them.
- C. To establish new local clubs and to promote the local club's new growth.
- D. To report on the activities of the local clubs within her district to the Board of Directors.
- E. To attend Board of Directors Meetings of the Texas Federation of Republican Women.
