Zenia Warren has been actively involved with the Republican Party of Texas, Republican Party of Bell County, and the Texas Federation of Republican Women for more than 15 years. She has served CTRW as President (2014, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022), 1st Vice President Programs, 2nd Vice President Membership, Americanism Chair, Awards Chair, Newsletter Editor and Website Manager for Central Texas Republican Women.

As TFRW 1st Vice President Special Events, Zenia has diligently kept the Leadership Handbook updated providing the most accurate information for TFRW members. Forms and Documents section on the TFRW website has been expanded with shortcuts so that members may easily access information. In addition, she has assisted Membership, maintaining an accurate accountability. She has implemented Google Docs files to maintain club master documents, membership submissions, and digital records. She received the TFRW Tribute to Women Honoree Award in 2014 and 2016, and the TFRW "10 Outstanding" Award in 2019. Currently a Deputy Voter Registrar, she has worked as an Election Judge, Clerk, and Ballot Board Member. She has worked on the Primary Committee for Bell County and is Precinct 214 Chair in Bell County. She also served as Bell County Republican Party Vice-Chair from 2014 to 2018. She has worked on many candidate steering committees and numerous campaigns including *Mighty Texas Strike Force* and *Victory 2020*. She has attended numerous conventions including RPT, NFRW, and TFRW. She has worked with the RPT in numerous campaign training classes as an instructor.
