

NFRW Americanism Award 2025

Introduction:

The NFRW Americanism Award was formed to promote the knowledge that America is the greatest and most free nation in the history of the world. We aim to promote honor and respect for our flag and country and to foster devotion to the exceptional United States.

Instructions:

The NFRW Americanism Award Form is to be completed by the State President and/or Americanism Chair. The State President must sign prior to submission. A state may submit only one submission for NFRW award consideration.

The form must be completed in its entirety, and contain the following attachments:

- Contact number/email for State President and/or Americanism Chair.
- · Samples of articles, social media, newsletters, etc.
- Pictures of member participating in the effort.
- Name(s) of partnering organization(s) in this project, if any.
- The signature of the State President.

Criteria:

- Look for someone doing exceptional unpaid volunteer work such as volunteering with first responders in the community, recruiting new members, people who do things.
- Actively campaigning for Republican candidates. Yard signs, door knocking, etc.
- Involved with promoting important legislation at state, county, city levels, such as speaking at Park Boards, School Boards, Supervisor meetings, City Council, etc.
- Outreach to minorities, to college students, church groups, etc.
- Educating voters about issues, concerns, etc.
- Activists such as those who participated at J6 Trump rally, etc.
- Recognizing, honoring contributions of others (including outside of clubs): educators, clergy, rescues, change makers, fundraisers.

Guidance for Scoring:

The member will be scored based on the following criteria by the NFRW Americanism Committee accordingly:

The Project – How did the person achieve the goals of supporting Americanism?

Documentation of the Project – Is there sufficient documentation included to properly assess the effort?

Club Involvement – Which club and organizations were involved in the effort?

Cooperation – Please document the impact to the club, state or specific organizations.

2.	Documentation of the Project
	Please document the effort, effect and raised awareness of Americanism in the community or across the state. This may be submitted as an additional document.
